Dear FPC Denton Church Family,

If you haven't noticed, I love to read devotionals. Some of my favorites are those that feature a-word-a-day. A new one that I bought is called *One Good Word a Day* by authors Fisk/Roehl/Demery. The word for January 14 was DE-CLARE. The Scripture verse is from John 17: 26: "I have declared to them your name, and will declare it, that the love with which you loved me may be in them, and I in them."

It begins with a scene probably familiar to lots of families—that of having guests over for dinner when one of the kids drops the question: "How come we only pray when other people come over?"

It wasn't the author's child that raised that question but she reflects: "As parents, how do we weave Jesus into the fabric of our lives—the morning routine, homework, dishes, snuggles, laughter, bedtime—so that our home carries his breath at every moment?"

Jesus, speaking aloud to his Father, ended his prayer by saying that he had declared the Father's name to his disciples so that the love of God would be in Jesus, and the love of Jesus would be in his disciples.

The author gives a great thought: "There's a strength in declaring something to be true. When we declare the truth of God's love and mercy to the world, it establishes the truth of our belief and reflects the love of the Father into the world." She goes on to say: "Put that way, Jesus' prayer to the Father becomes a prayer we can pray over our own lives: that we will continue to make his name known. And that the love with which he has loved us may be in us, and in our families.

The author's prayer: "Lord, help us to declare your name and make your love known. Amen."

For further reflection: Brainstorm a new way to demonstrate God's love in your household.



### Shrimp Casserole (page 153)

$\frac{1}{2}$  large onion, chopped  
1 Tbsp. butter  
 $1\frac{1}{4}$  lb. shrimp, cleaned and cooked  
1 can cream of mushroom soup  
 $\frac{1}{2}$  Tbsp. lemon juice  
dash garlic salt  
Salt and pepper to taste  
 $\frac{3}{4}$  c. cooked rice  
 $\frac{1}{2}$  bell pepper, cut in rings and boiled for 2 minutes  
 $\frac{1}{2}$  c. sour cream  
 $\frac{3}{4}$  c. grated cheese




Sauté onion in butter until tender, add soup, lemon juice, and seasonings. Fold in rice and shrimp. Add sour cream. Pour into buttered 2 quart casserole; sprinkle with cheese. Decorate with pepper rings. Bake in a 325° oven for 30 minutes. Serves 6.


