Here's a short devotional that caught my eye this month entitled *The Easiest and Hardest Thing* by John Michalak.

1 John 3: 16-18: "By this we know love, because he laid down his life for us. And we ought to lay down our lives for the brothers. But whoever has the world's goods, and sees his brother in need, and closes his heart of compassion against him, how does God's love remain in him? My little children, let's not love in word only, neither with the tongue only, but in deed and truth."

Love is both the easiest and hardest thing. In so many ways, love is easy. It's as easy as smiling at a stranger on the street. It's as easy as offering some money to a homeless man. Love is both the easiest and the hardest thing for flawed, imperfect humans like you and me. But love is always the greatest thing. God is love. He invites us to become more and more like Him so we can be love too!

Prayer: Loving Heavenly Lord, help me to show your love to others. Help me freely share the material things with which you have blessed me. May I never close my eyes or my heart to one of your children in need. In Jesus' name I pray. Amen.

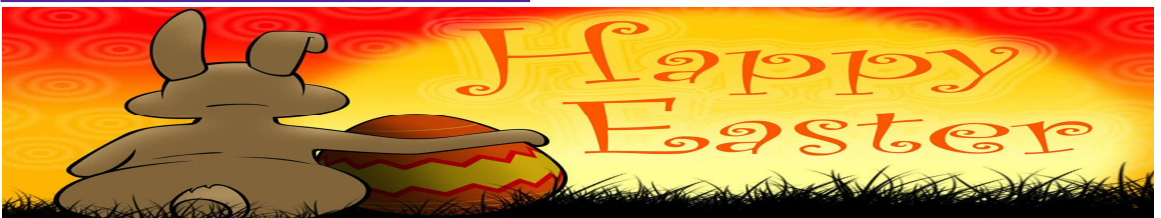

Love Notes from Pastor Debbie

We've had some cold weather but on the whole it has been rather mild. We will see if this nice weather holds! We are already in the midst of Lent with Palm Sunday on March 24 and Easter on March 31. The Lenten and Easter season is one of my favorites. Plan to attend the special events: a special musical presentation at 4 p.m. on March 24, Maundy Thursday (March 28), Good Friday, and both an early and an 11:00 service on Easter!



Here are the readings for March:

March 3: Third Sunday in Lent. Communion. Readings: Exodus 20: 1-17; Psalm 19; John 2: 13-22; 1 Corinthians 1: 18-25. Sermon Title: "The Wisdom of God". Exodus 20, Psalm 19 and 1 Corinthians 1 texts. Theme: Wisdom of God.

March 10: Fourth Sunday in Lent. Readings: Numbers 21: 4-9; Psalm 107: 1-3, 17-22; John 3: 14-21; Ephesians 2: 1-10. Sermon Title: "Love and Grace". All four texts. Theme: Love and Grace.

March 17: Fifth Sunday in Lent. Readings: Psalm 51: 1-12; Jeremiah 31: 31-34; John 12: 20-33; Hebrews 5: 5-10. Sermon Title: "Christ's Priesthood". Hebrews 5 text. Theme: Christ's Priesthood.

March 24: Palm Sunday. PALM Readings: Psalm 118: 1-2, 19-29; Mark 11: 1-11. Sermon Title: "This is the Lord's Doing". Psalm and Mark 11 texts. Theme: Power and Wisdom of God. PASSION Readings: Psalm 31: 9-16; Isaiah 50: 4-9a; Mark 14: 1-15: 47; Philippians 2: 5-11.

THURSDAY. March 28: Maundy Thursday. Dinner/Service/Communion. Readings: Exodus 12: 1-14; Psalm 116: 1-4, 12-19; John 13: 1-17, 31b-35; 1 Corinthians 11: 23-26. Sermon Title: "Flowing" All four texts. Theme: Love, Service, Communion/Remembrance.

FRIDAY. March 29: Good Friday. Readings: Psalm 22; Isaiah 52: 13-53: 12; John 18: 1-19: 42; Hebrews 10: 16-25. Sermon Title: "Casting Lots". Part of the John 18/19 text. Theme: A look at the witnesses and how we fit in.

March 31: Resurrection Sunday/Easter Sunday. 2 Services/Brunch/Communion. Readings: Psalm 18: 1-2, 14-24; Mark 16: 1-8 or John 20: 1-18; Acts 10: 34-43; 1 Corinthians 15: 1-11. Easter One service Sermon Title: "Whom Are You Looking For?" John 20 and Mark 16 texts. Theme: Resurrection. Easter Two service Sermon Title: "The Good News" Acts 10 and 1 Corinthians 15 texts. Theme: Resurrection.

Souper Bowl of Caring

Thank you to everyone who participated in the Souper Bowl of Caring collection! We began with a goal of 360 food items so that the 36 children at Denton Christian Preschool could have 10 cans each. Then we found out there were 40 kids so we changed our goal to 400 food items. At the end of our collection, we had 481 food items. On top of that, the family of Charles Bratton had donated Charlie's food pantry to augment not only our Little Free Food Pantry but also our Souper Bowl of Caring collection. That was a total of 114 food items. Denton Christian Preschool received from us 595 food items!!!! Our Outreach Committee gave DCP one of our green bags for each student in which they could carry their food home. Please see the photos!!!!

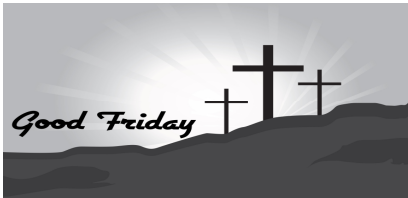

Apricot Nut Bread

(page 177)

- 1 c. dried apricots
- 1 c. sugar
- 2 Tbsp. Crisco
- 1 egg
- 1 c. nuts
- 2 c. flour
- 2 tsp. baking powder
- ½ tsp. soda
- 1 tsp. salt
- ¼ c. sugar
- ½ c. orange juice



Soak chopped, dried apricots about 20 minutes. Drain well. Cream 1 cup sugar, Crisco and egg. Add dry ingredients alternately with orange juice which has been mixed with ¼ c. sugar. Add apricots and nuts. Bake in greased and floured loaf pan at 350° about 1 hour.

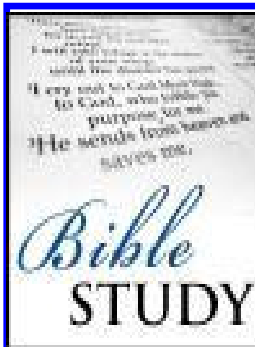

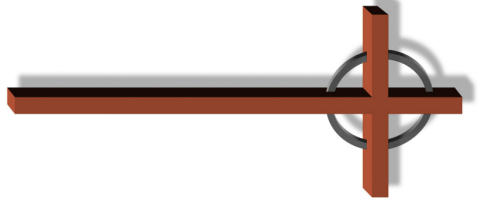
