Dear FPC Denton Church Family,

I loved the idea behind this book: *Every Moment Holy*. It's a beautiful book of prayers for a variety of activities, including ordinary ones like preparing a meal or doing the laundry. Author Douglas Kaine McKelvey includes liturgies for the ordinary events of daily life such as "A Liturgy for Feasting with Friends" or "A Liturgy for Laundering" or "A Liturgy for the First Hearth fire of the Season". These prayers have a way of reminding us that our lives are shot through with sacred purpose even when, especially when, we are too busy or too caught up in our busyness to notice. His hope is that the prayers encourage readers to practice mindfulness of the constant presence of God and draw them toward greater recognition of the eternal echoes resounding in every moment of our lives.

G. K. Chesterton wrote: "You say grace before meals. All right. But I say grace before sketching, painting, swimming, fencing, boxing, walking, playing, dancing and grace before I dip my pen in the ink."

Sometimes we are inclined to divide our activities into ones that appear to have spiritual value, like reading devotions before a meal, and other activities I think have little spiritual value, such as doing the dishes after the meal. Paul erased that divide in a letter to the people of Colossae who had chosen to live for Jesus. He encouraged them with these words: "Whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus. (Colossians 3: 17). Doing things in Jesus' name means both honoring Him as we do them and having the assurance that His Spirit helps strengthen us to accomplish them. "Whatever you do." All the ordinary activities of our lives, every moment, can be empowered by God's Spirit and done in a way that honors Jesus.

Also, prayers for safety for all those traveling! Some of my sermons this month will deal with some of those "tough" questions.



Here are the readings for August:

August 6: 10th Sunday after Pentecost. Communion. Genesis 32: 22-31; Psalm 17: 1-7, 15; Matthew 14: 13-21; Romans 9: 1-5. Sermon Title: "Evidence of God's Existence". Sermon Text: various texts.

August 13: 11th Sunday after Pentecost. Genesis 37: 1-4, 12-28; Psalm 105: 1-6, 16-22, 45b; Matthew 14: 22-33; Romans 10: 5-15. Sermon Title: "The Question of Evil and Suffering" Sermon Texts: Genesis 37 and various texts.

August 20: 12th Sunday after Pentecost. Genesis 45: 1-15; Psalm 133; Matthew 15: 10-28; Romans 11: 1-2a, 29-32. Sermon Title: "Joseph's Story" Sermon Text: Genesis 45. Reconciliation.

August 27: 13th Sunday after Pentecost. Exodus 1: 8-2:10; Psalm 124; Matthew 16: 13-20; Romans 12: 1-8. Sermon Title: "Morality" Sermon Text: various texts.



Our Pastor Nominating Committee was voted on July 23rd for the full-time pastor. Those elected are: Sally Callahan, Beverly Hoch, Terry Nobles, Carolyn Smith and Jim Welborn.

They will create the "advertisement" called the Ministry Information Form, based on input from the congregation that was gathered last fall. Eventually, through prayer, deliberation, observation and interviewing, one candidate will be invited and called to fill our pulpit. Please keep this committee in your daily prayers, and also pray that the heart of "God's choice" will be prepared to come join us.



Mission News

The Mission Committee is giving money to support Interfaith Ministries in their Operation Backpack initiative. They are providing backpacks and school supplies for students returning to school in August.

A collection will be set up in the narthex for Denton Christian Pre School to donate "start up" needs as the children return. These needs are for toilet tissue, paper towels, antibacterial soap, Kleenexes, sanitizing wipes, construction paper, Manila paper, Crayola Crayons, Copy Paper and Glue sticks. The Mission Committee will collect these over the next 2 weeks, School begins August 14th! The Denton Christian Preschool appreciates anything they can get donated.

The food pantry is doing well. Many members of the community have been donating food. The Denton Water Project, which is set up next to the pantry, is currently being restocked 3 times a day with ice and bottles of water. 

- 1 (7½ oz.) pkg. macaroni and cheese dinner

- 2 Tbsp. chopped onion
- 2 Tbsp. margarine
- ½ lb. frankfurters, sliced
- 1 Tbsp. mustard

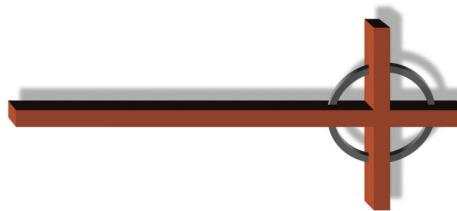
